

MINOR BEHAVIOURS

SCHOOL-WICE POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

MAJOR BEHAVIOURS

REFOCUS

Provide non-verbal and/or visual cue (Check your Choices cards). Private/subtle response.

REDIRECT

State and demonstrate the expected behaviour from the matrix.

RETEACH

Student will demonstrate the desired behaviour and teacher will provide immediate feedback.

RELOCATE &
REFLECT

Direct the student to an isolated space within your classroom to complete the reflection sheet and share with teacher.

RETHINK

Give student two alternatives: the desired behaviour or a less preferred choice (i.e miss out on part of recess). Give student think time. Provide positive feedback throughout the process.

REPORT/ RECORD Contact parent via phone/ email/note etc.

MINORS

- Not following instructions/school rules
- Calling out, interrupting, speaking out of turn
- Not being safe when moving around
- Not being on task when working on an activity
- Physical contact without intent to harm
- **♦** Littering
- Disrupting other learners
- Continuing to play when the music plays (before school and end of recess and lunch)
- Speaking disrespectfully to/about others
- Excluding others
- Not wearing a hat outside in Term 1 and 4
- Out of bounds
- Swearing during a conversation or game/accidental swearing when injuring yourself
- Students not agreeing to rules of a game
- Playing in the toilets

MAJORS

- Leaving the school grounds
- ♦ Fighting (punching/kicking/serious wrestling)
- Swearing at another person
- Repeatedly targeting others (bullying)
- Harming others intentionally
- Sexually explicit and inappropriate language/actions
- ♦ Threatening/intimidation
- ♦ Continually excluding others
- Stealing
- Vandalism of school or others' property
- Persistently refusing to follow instructions/school rules
- ♦ Talking back/rudely to adults
- Defiant repetition of minor behaviours

Assess situation whilst monitoring student and staff safety. Remove triggers/evacuate the area if required.

ASSESS & MONITOR

Evaluate the level of risk/safety and seek assistance from Principal if required.

EVALUATE

Direct students to an isolated space to de-escalate the situation (calm). Brief the Principal on the situation and determine who will lead next steps.

SUPPORT

Principal/teacher to use open questions to determine the sequence of events ensuring everyone has a voice. This may be individual or in a group.

UNPACK

Debrief with relevant parties and determine consequences.

REFLECT

Contact parents/guardians in a timely manner. Record on Chronicles. Report the reportable incidents to DET.

NOTIFY

Calm Consistent Brief Immediate Respectful Specific
